## Getting to the ASRC

### By Car

#### From the north (eg Glasgow and the M8)

Westbound on the M8, after crossing the River Clyde on the Kingston Bridge, take the exit (Junction 22) for the M77 signposted Kilmarnock, Prestwick Airport. Continue on the M77, which turns into the A77, following signs for Prestwick Airport and Ayr until you reach the first roundabout for Ayr where you take the first exit onto the B743, signposted Mauchline.

#### From the south (eg South Ayrshire, Dumfries and Galloway)

Travelling north on the A77, continue forward until you reach the third roundabout for Ayr. Take the fourth exit onto the B743, signposted Mauchline.

#### From the south (eg M6 and M74)

Heading north on the M6, continue forward onto the A74/M74. Take the A70 at junction 12 on the M74 and head west through Douglas, Muirkirk, Colyton, following signs for Ayr. On meeting the A77 on the outskirts of Ayr take the third exit on the roundabout and head north on the A77. At the next roundabout take the fourth exit onto the B743, signposted Mauchline.

### All routes

Once on the B743 (and heading east) from the roundabout, you pass the Hannah Research Institute on your left and SAC Ayr on the Auchincruive Estate follows on your right hand side. Take the right turn into the main entrance. Take the first road on the left (passing some car park entrances on your left), and pass under the security barrier. At the T-junction, turn right and, in approximately 30 metres, park in the car park on the left in front of the Temple Mount Building. The ASRC reception is in the Temple Mount Cottage, the building to the left of the car park.

### By Taxi

If travelling by taxi, from the centre of Ayr or Prestwick Airport, ask for The Scottish Agricultural College on the Auchincruive Estate. A taxi from Ayr train station will cost about £6.50 and a taxi from Prestwick Airport will cost around £7

### By Train

Ayr train station offers a regular service to Glasgow with connections to the rest of the UK. A service also runs between Ayr and Stranraer, for ferry services to Ireland

### By Air

**Glasgow Prestwick Airport** (is approximately 10 minutes from the ASRC and offers connecting flights to cities throughout the UK as well as Europe.

**Glasgow International Airport** is approximately 50 minutes driving time from the ASRC.

**Edinburgh International Airport** is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes driving time from the ASRC.
