Declarations will only be produced for animals that are either from a BVD free accredited herd or have been individually tested for the presence of BVD antigen (or virus) and found to be negative. Animals should be blood tested between 6 and 12 weeks before the sale; this applies for BVD antibody, L hardjo antibody and IBR antibody. For BVD antigen (virus) a single blood test producing a negative result from one month of age can be used for these health declarations.

Timing of Vaccinations

The available vaccines for BVD now have a general recommendation that no other vaccine should be administered within 14 days before or after vaccination with the product. However note that Spirovac is now licenced to be administered on the same day, but not mixed with, PregSure BVD. This creates difficulties where there is to be a signed veterinary declaration that vaccination has taken place, as with multiple vaccinations four vet visits will be required rather than two where vaccination against a single disease is to be carried out.

You should note that we are neither encouraging the use of vaccines contrary to the manufacturers' instructions nor are we advocating that all animals should be vaccinated prior to a sale. Note that Rispoval 4 is not licenced for the protection of breeding stock against BVD. We advise that if animals are vaccinated the information on the vaccines used should be made available to potential buyers.

We also recommend that where vaccination is considered then BVD is the most important vaccine from the perspective of selling bulls through market. Of the other vaccines, IBR is next in importance. By using the IBR marker vaccine vaccinated animals can be sold to IBR accredited herds, however even when using these marker vaccines animals will be precluded from breeding studs selling semen to EU countries and will be ineligible for export to certain countries.
